#### TIPS FOR BOARD OFFICERS TRANSITION

As this school year comes to an end, we would like to provide a few tips to help with the transition of Board Officers of your local Pre-SOMA chapter. To guarantee the continuation of your chapter, former board members should:

- Provide a list of the new officers with their contact information to the organization's advisor and National Pre-SOMA directors.
- Schedule a meeting with Incoming Officers to discuss roles responsibilities, expectations, and goals.
- Provide credentials for the email and/or social media accounts.
- Connect Incoming Board Officers with chapter resources: speakers, medical students, other organizations leaders, etc.
- Help create an agenda for the upcoming school year.
- Give access to the chapter's bank account to the corresponding officers.

Do not forget to explain to the Incoming Officers that each Pre-SOMA chapter must submit a School Year Plan (agenda) of possible activities at the beginning of the Fall term and an End of The Year report at the end of the Spring term.

#### CONTINUED GROWTH OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE

Reaching yet another high, 91.3% of the 7,303 participating DO students matched into residency programs in 41 specialties, the most specialties ever recorded for DO Match Day placements, with 38 reported in the 2021 Match!

Overall, the number of osteopathic fourth-year students who matched into PGY1 positions increased by 5.4% from last year. Final placement numbers will be available in May and are expected to exceed the 99% rate reported in prior years.
